WSET Level 1 Wine Online

The Level 1 introductory course offers a well-rounded introduction to wine, major wines of the world, and food and wine pairing principles. Consider this class if you are relatively new to wine and would like to expand your knowledge, especially tasting skills, and move to the next level. By the end of the course, you'll be able to taste wine using a systematic approach to tasting and be able to identify the main styles of wine.

The course will be based around a four-week, five module online learning program with educator support available for this time. The course modules should be followed in sequential order during this four-week window. The course material should take about six hours in total to complete, plus revision time. Regular access and participation in the course online activities is essential for this mode of study. The course prepares the student for the qualifications and they are guided by a WSET educator. The student can contact the educator any time for the duration of the scheduled course, should they have any questions. Each module includes a series of independent activities to help students understand the differences between grape varieties and types and styles of wine. Students should be advised to taste a range of wines during their studies. All the required wines for the course can be found in the online equipment list. Any additional wines can be found in the Specification. Students can post their tasting notes in the Online Classroom for review by the educator.

The WSET level 1 award exam is in person at Corvina Wine Company. The exam will take place on Saturday January 13th 1:00 pm.

Students are expected to arrive at the exam venue on the scheduled date and time with their photo id, two pencils and an eraser. WSET level 1 award exam contains 30 multiple choice questions to be completed in 45 minutes. The passing score required to receive the WSET level 1 award in wine certificate is 70%. The exam takes about 1 hour and 15 minutes, including the exam instructions and the 45- minute multiple-choice test. You will receive your exam result via email approximately 3 weeks after your exam date. Receiving your certificate may take one or two additional weeks.

Recommended wine tasting samples will be available at Corvina for retail purchase at a discounted rate for WSET students. Additionally, students will be offered a discounted wine tasting flight at Corvina Wine Bar to practice tasting with the Level 1 systematic approach. A list of recommended wines for WSET L1 wine is available in the specification and will be sent with registration.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Full payment must be made at time of booking; your place in the course is confirmed once payment is received. Students will receive a confirmation email with receipt. No advanced reservations for place in course are accepted; your place will be secured only upon completion of the payment.

2. Course materials are provided to students on the first day of the course. They will not be posted in advance.

3. The student must provide personal information to receive the final WSET certificate and to book a course place. Every change/update in the personal data must be communicated to Midwest Wine Center. It is important for the student to provide a complete and accurate delivery address. Any materials returned to Midwest Wine Center having not been successfully received by the student, will automatically result in an additional cost of return being charged.

4. Cancellations, Refunds, and Re sit

All course and examination fees must be paid in full upon signing the enrollment agreement by check, cash, or credit card. Course transfers of a confirmed booking either to another course or applicant can be made up to 14 days before the course start date on payment of a \$50.00 administrative fee plus the cost of any additional study materials which may be applicable. Course transfers cannot be carried forward to a subsequent academic year. Students wishing to cancel their online course less than 5 working days prior to the course start date, or at any time after the course has started, no refund or transfer of the course fees will be made. Requests for registration after the registration deadline will be considered on a case by case basis and will be assessed a \$50 late registration processing fee.

Due to WSET exam order deadlines, all examination transfer requests must be made at least 30 days prior to the original examination date in order to avoid paying a new exam fee. Examination dates are connected to the course that you book and any transfer to an alternative date will incur an administration fee of \$50. Requests for rescheduling within 30 days prior to the exam date will incur new exam fees as follows: \$200.00. If the exam change request is late or if a student is not present on the scheduled exam date, a new exam fee of \$200.00 will apply.
